

**LINDA HOUSTON RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS SCHOLARSHIP
STUDENT REQUIREMENTS**

Recipient Criteria:

The scholarship recipient is

1. Enrolled full-time (12 hours or more)
2. Maintains a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher OR for newly enrolled students, earn a GPA of 2.0 or higher in their first semester.
3. Be in good academic standing.
4. Must be employed working at least 20 hrs. per week and can include a work-study or on-campus job.
5. Subject to the requirements stated above, the recipient will receive an amount of \$750.00 per month for living expenses per school semester. For purposes of these requirements, if a semester starts on or before the 15th day of the month, that month will be considered a full month for purposes of the recipient receiving the full \$750.00 monthly stipend. Likewise, if a semester ends on or after the 15th day of a month, that month will be considered a full month for purposes of the recipient receiving the full \$750.00 monthly stipend.
6. The recipient will submit, via email, to the Haskell Foundation (at an email address provided by the Haskell Foundation to the recipient) by the fifth (5th) day of each month, receipts for each month of the semester that they are enrolled at Haskell University, the living expenses specified in 7 below.
7. Receipts showing a minimum of \$750.00 of monthly expenses will be submitted. These receipts will be for living expenses which can include: rent, groceries, utility bills, and child care. Receipts can not include any restaurant or “fast food” dining.
8. Once \$750.00 or more of monthly expenses have been provided, the Haskell Foundation will submit a check request to its accountants, KINDRED C.P.A. and KINDRED will deliver a check to the Haskell Foundation in the amount of \$750 payable to the scholarship recipient; and the Haskell Foundation will promptly mail the monthly check to the recipient’s mailing address.
9. For the purpose of assisting the applicant to establish a budget, the following are amounts that may be typical for 2021-2022 school year:

<u>Possible budget expenses:</u>	<u>Budget income:</u>
\$ 700 housing	-\$750 scholarship living expenses/rent/, utilities, food
\$ 180 utilities (gas, electricity)	-\$640 20/hr. week work, student
<u>\$ 400 food (\$13/day)</u>	
\$1,280 month, total expenses	-\$1,390 total income
Total value of scholarship is= \$750/ month x 12 months = \$9,000	
10. The scholarship recipient will present receipts to the Haskell Foundation for travel to Lawrence, Kansas to begin the first semester. Receipts will be for airplane, train, bus or gas from their application point of origin to Haskell Indian Nations University for the scholarship recipient and one other person. This amount will be in addition to the \$750/month stipend specified in paragraph 9. above.
11. The recipient acknowledges that the monthly \$750.00 stipend is subject to continued verification of the requirements for receipt of the stipend being fully satisfied; and further, fully subject the Linda Houston Foundation’s willingness to continue to fund this scholarship, which funding may be discontinued by the Linda Houston Foundation at any time and for any reason.

2. An essay not more than one page, double spaced, and answering the question: "What does Random Acts of Kindness mean to you?" 3. An essay not more than one page, double spaced, and answering the question: "What are your life dreams and goals?"
